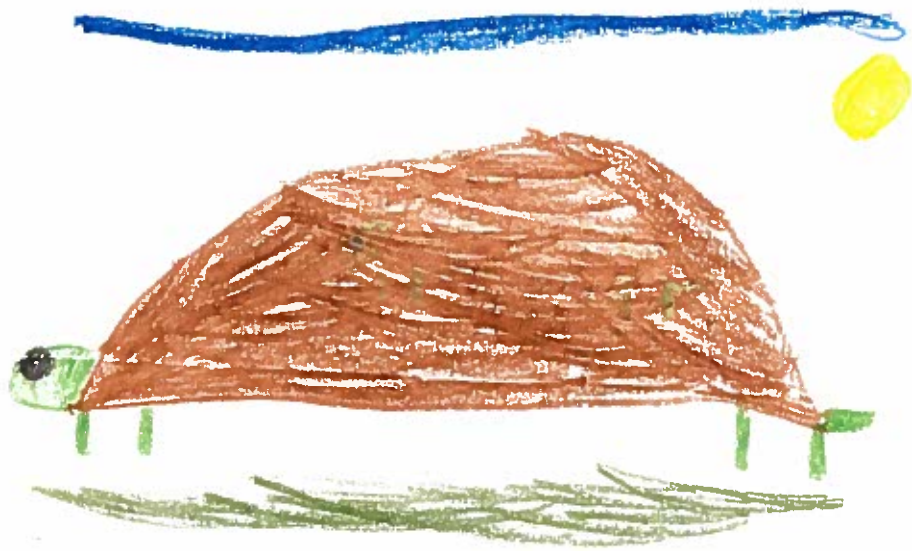

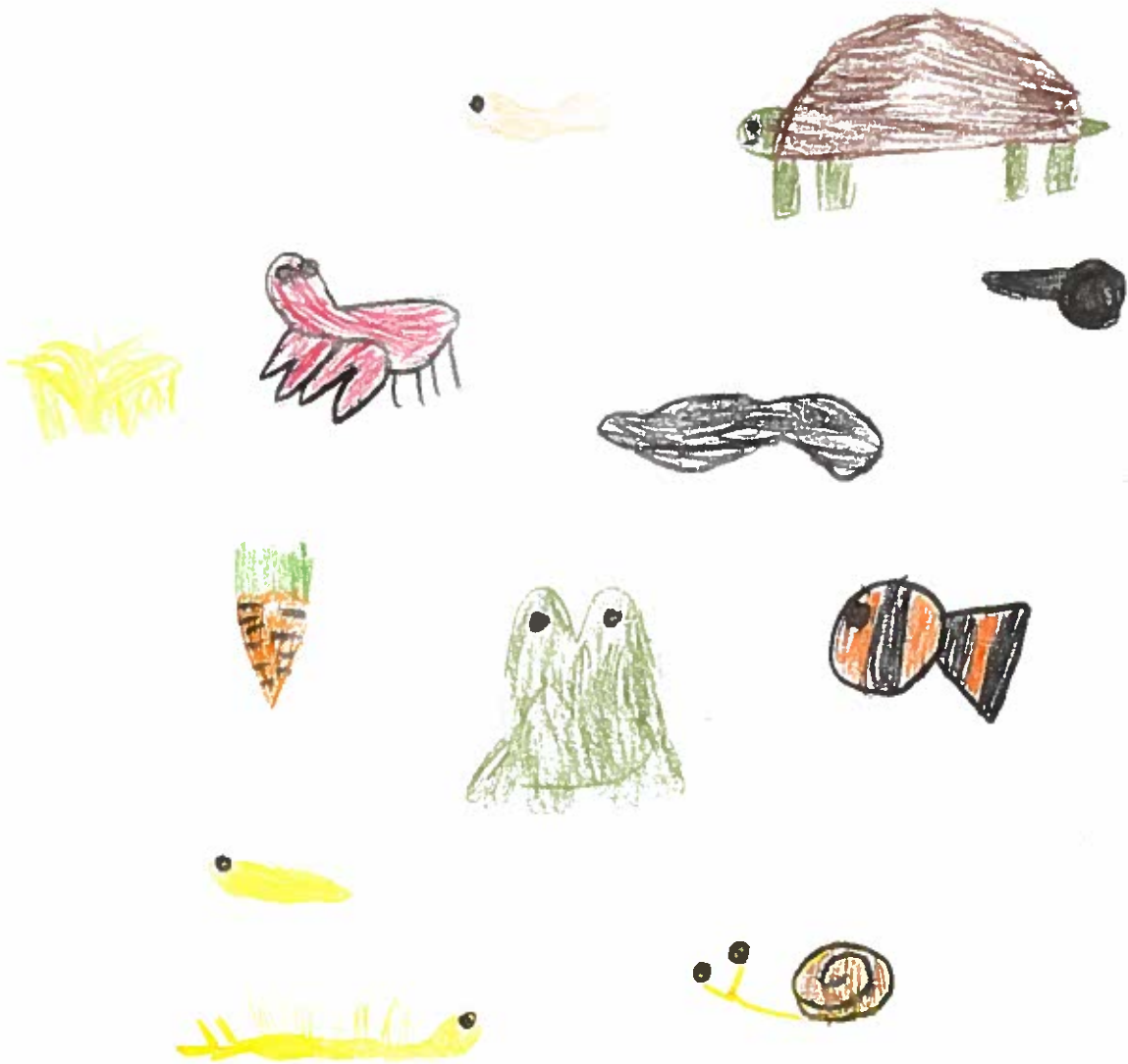

The Yellow Mud Turtle

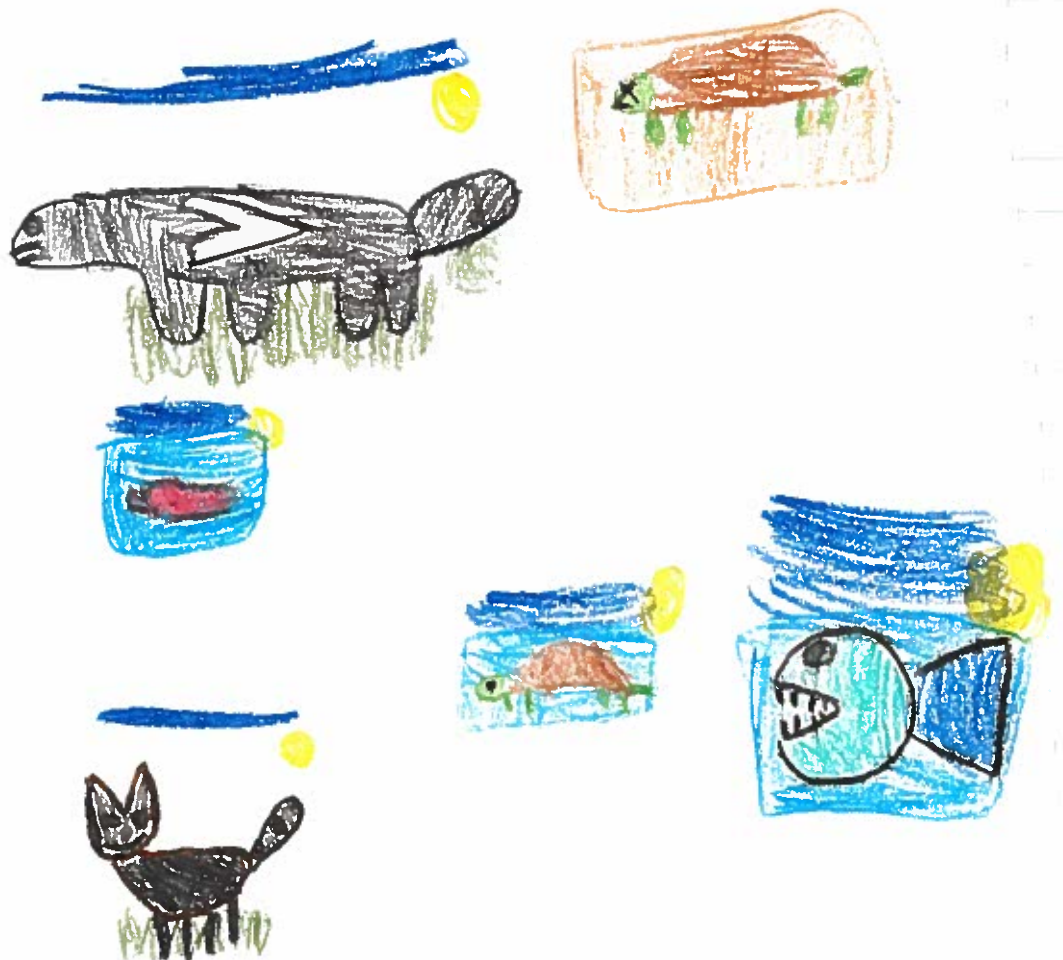
The yellow mud turtle eats

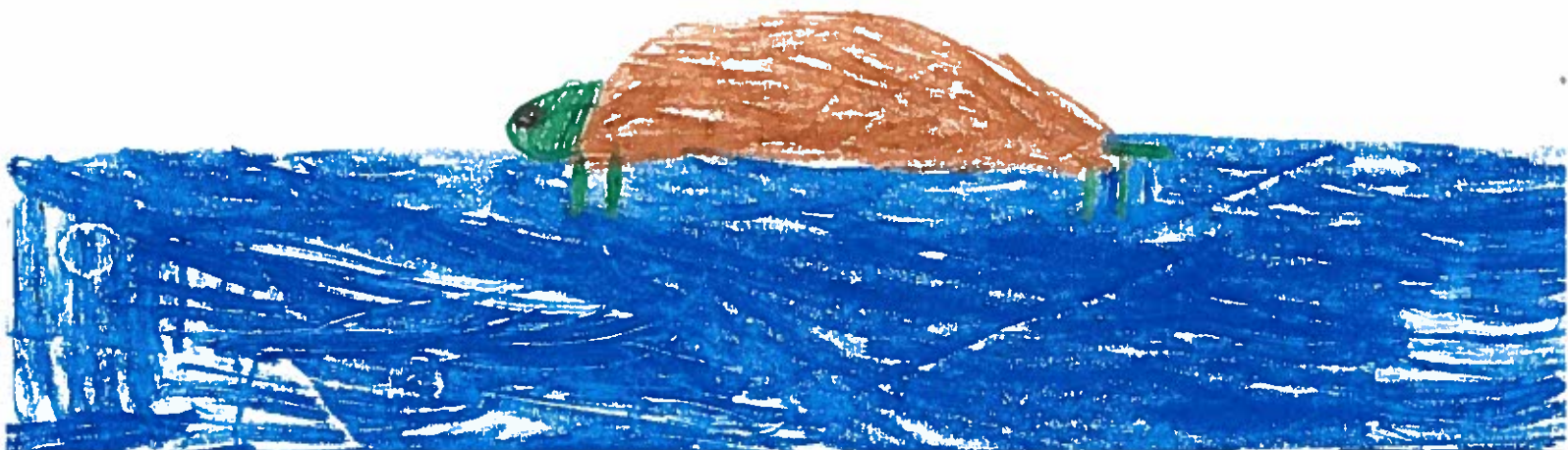

surface of the ground.



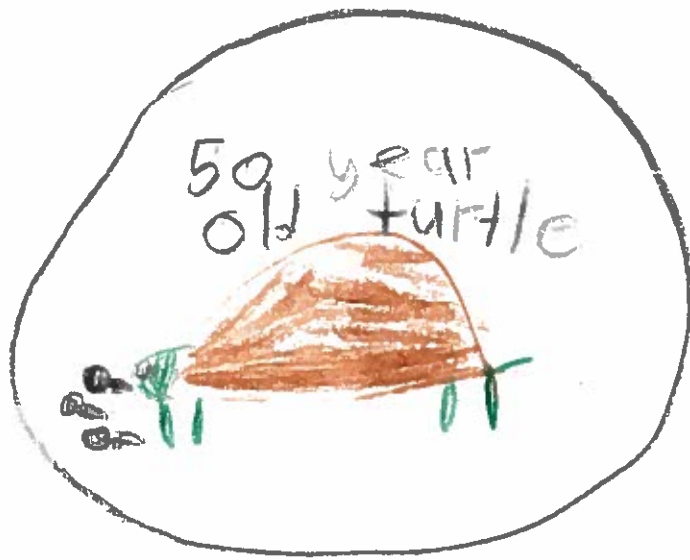
